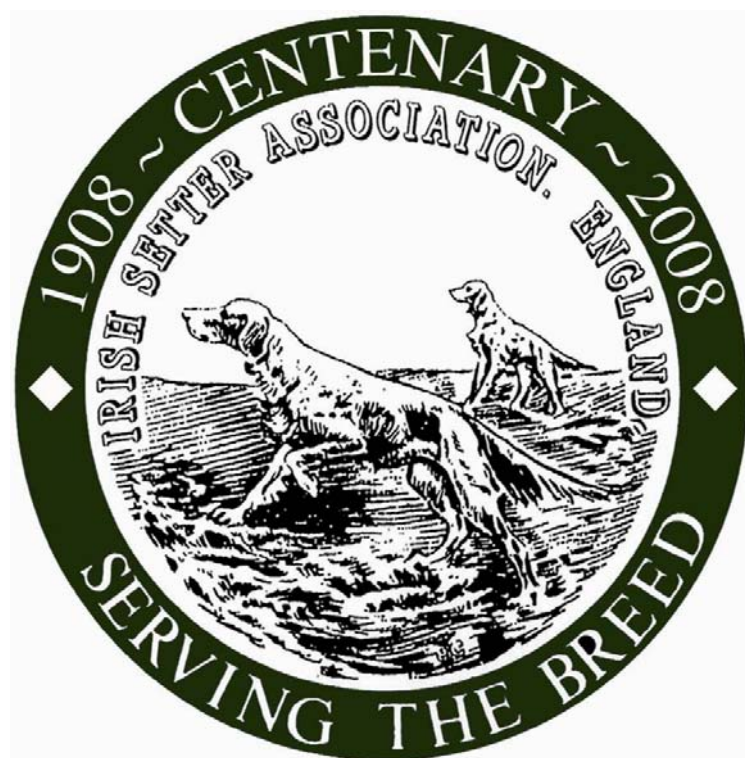

The year will commence with a special “CC winners” match and “Puppy winners” match, to be held on 23rd February.

Outline: A daytime event, with puppies judged in the morning followed by lunch and the CC winners judged in the afternoon – a change to our usual ‘dinner dance’ format. The “Puppy winners” match will be open to those winning best puppy dog or best puppy bitch at championship shows during 2007. A maximum of 64 dogs can be entered in each competition. Our Feature Event

July 17th – 19th 2008

Our main event of the year will be staged at the East of England Showground, Peterborough between 17th and 19th July. This will follow the East of England championship show – where Gundogs will be judged on 16th July. The Committee will be on site at the showground on 17th July and hope to welcome many overseas and UK exhibitors who have travelled to participate in this special event.

Our host hotel will be the Marriott Hotel, Lynch Wood, Peterborough. All those staying on the evening of 17th July are invited to join the Committee and other Officials for dinner at the Hotel. Andrew Brace has been invited to provide a talk on his life with dogs during the evening. Further details of the evening will be provided in a future release.
